

Dear parents/carers,

Hope you are keeping well and we are looking forward to welcoming your child back to school.

We have been busy preparing the school to minimise risks by putting in various protective measures which was highlighted in the letter received last week.

The pastoral teacher for your child will have informed you of which day they will be attending each week.

Key Information:

- If you are bringing your child into school there will be a parent drop off in the 6 bays immediately to the left when you pull into the school car park. Please arrive at 9am and collect your child at 2:45pm. It is important to adhere to these times as we are having to stagger times because of the volume of traffic in the car park.
- Students will be met by staff at the front of the school and escorted to their zone entrance.
- On the school website in the COVID resource section there is a welcome back video for you to share with your child which will help them to understand how the school will be organised.
- For the remainder of this term it is your decision whether you would like your child to be in uniform or not.
- We are requesting that students do not bring in any of their own personal possessions in order to minimise risk of transmission.
- Can we remind families that if their child or a household member is symptomatic that you do not send your child in and let the school know as soon as possible. Can we also kindly remind families that social distancing measures must be adhered to outside of school.
